With a \$250 million net worth, Grant Hill's 18-season NBA career paved the way for successful entrepreneurial ventures, including a lifetime deal with Fila.



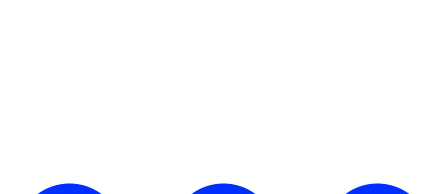
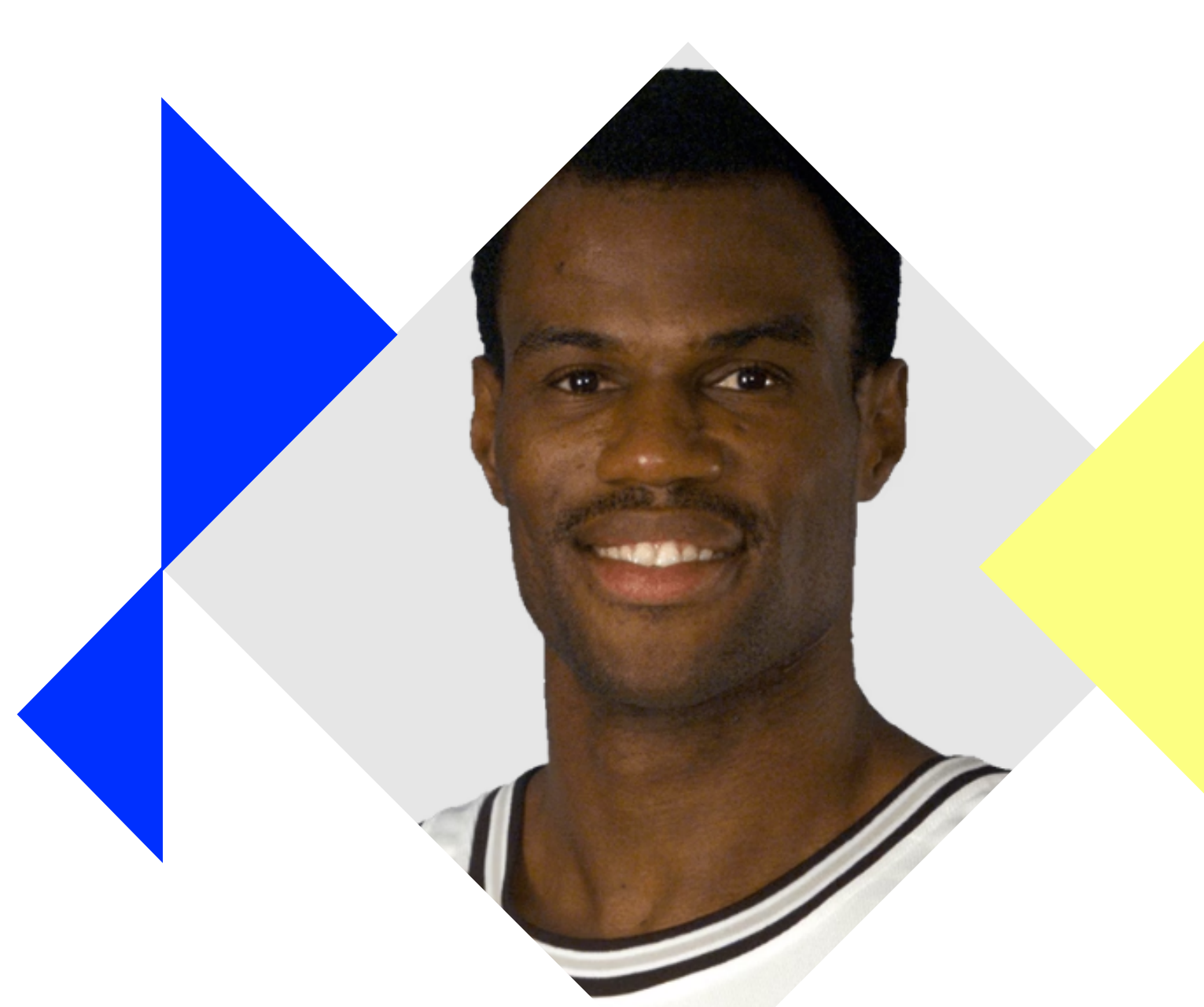

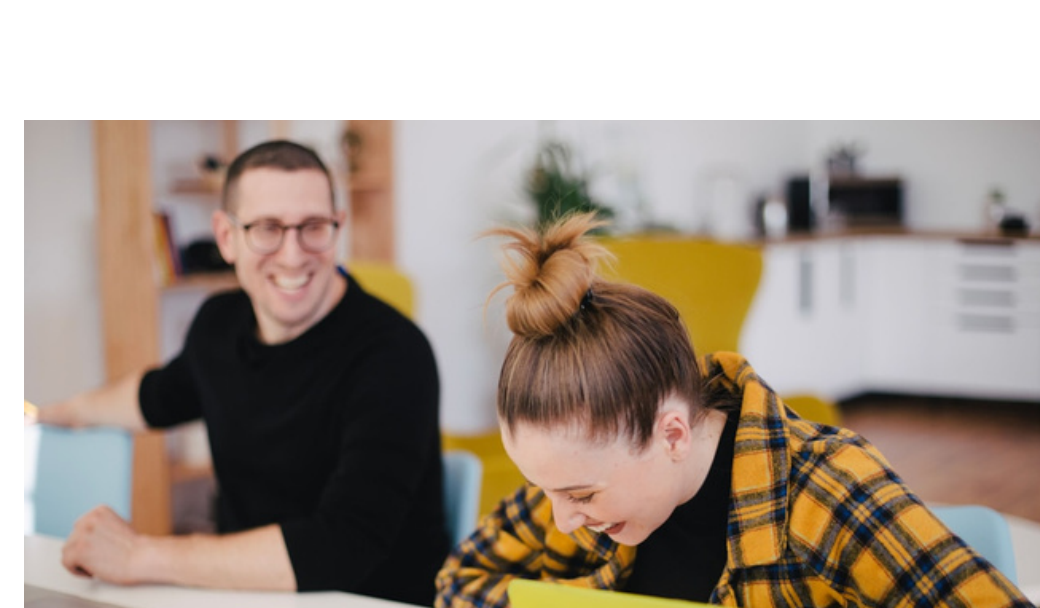

Listen and Communicate Effectively

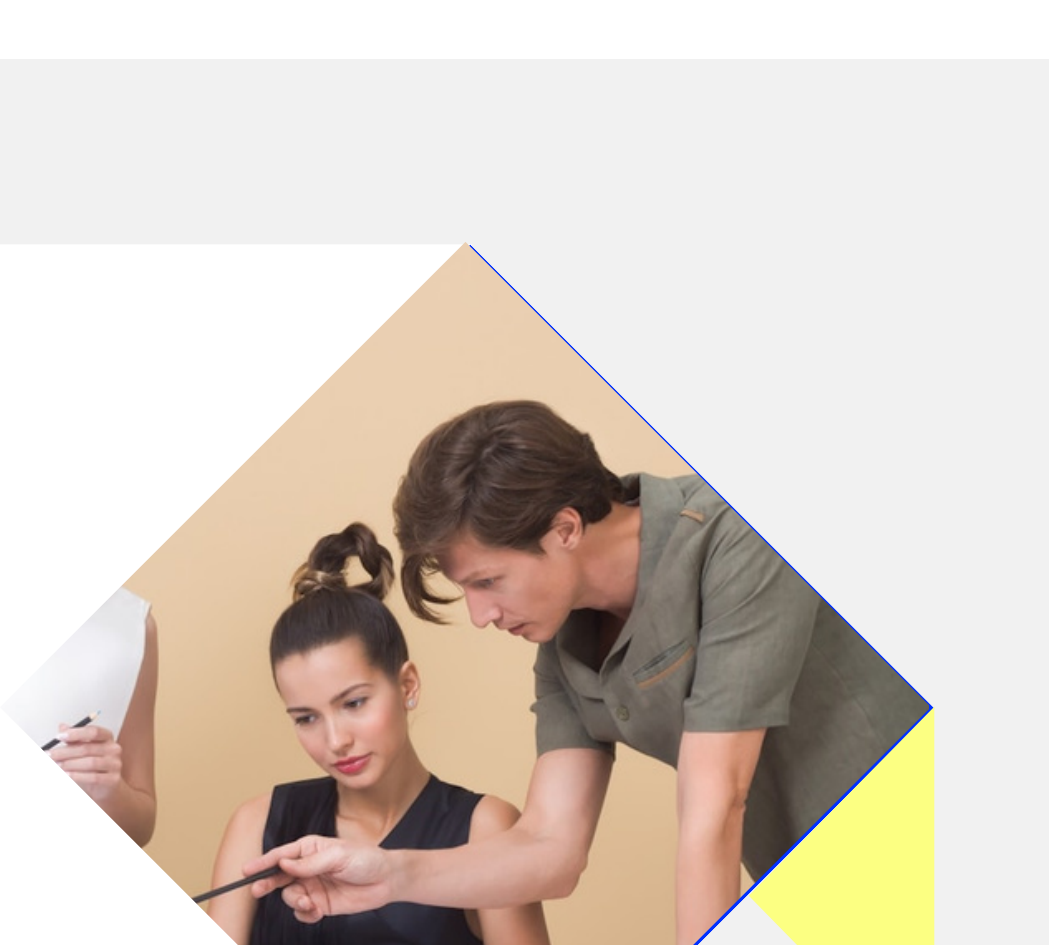

If leaders seem discouraged or apathetic, members of the group are likely to also become uninspired.

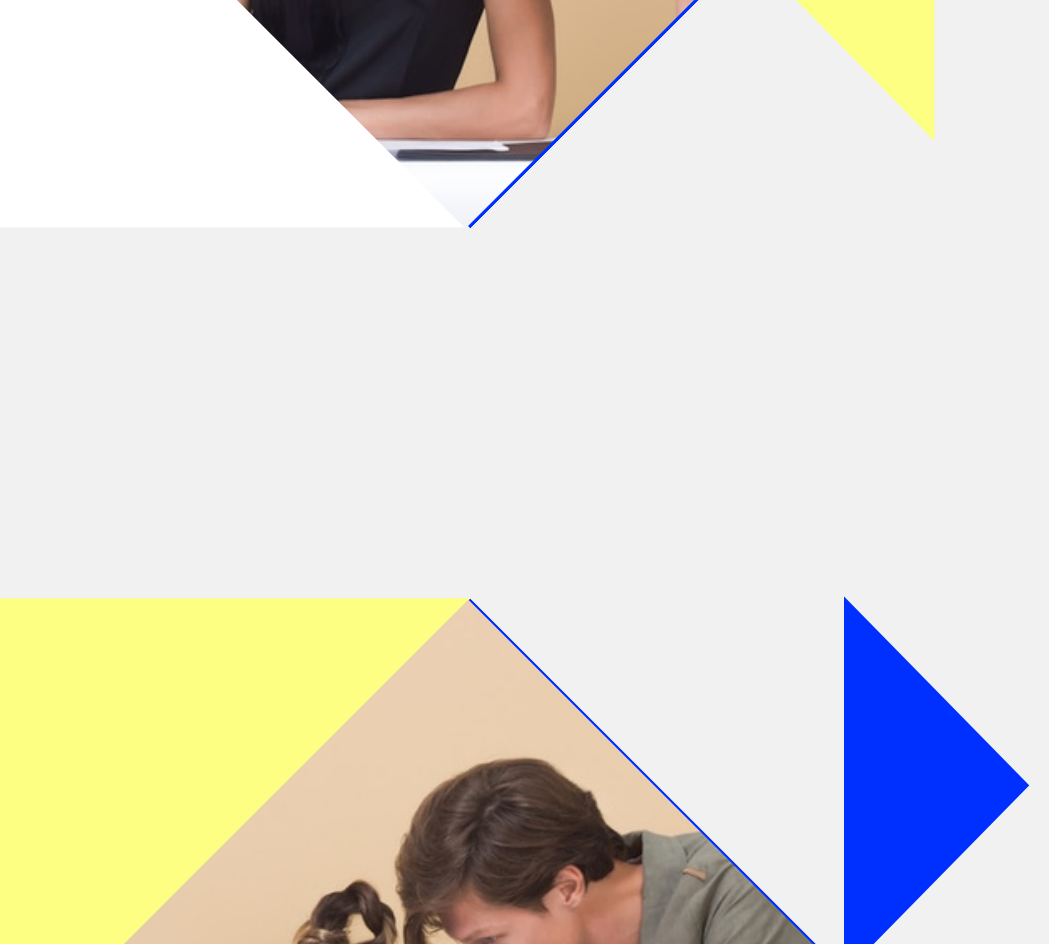
